## Techniques to Review Content Objectives:

Read text backwards	Review chapter and questions
Competition – race, relay, jeopardy	Student write questions
Concentration	Bingo
Posters	Quick exit
Timelines	First, then, last books
Powerpoint	Write letters
Pair share	Kooshball wrap-up
Journal	Music
3D presentation	Conga line

## Favorite 5-minute wrap-up activities:

Outcome sentences	KWL – look back
Inner/Outer circles	Think pair share
Kooshball questions	Slap it game
Quick writes	Song
Draw it	Making words
Looks like, sounds like	Around the world
Baseball	Games

## Techniques to Provide Informal Feedback to Students:

Positive reinforcement	Gestures
Expressions	Direct oral feedback
Modeling	Acknowledge response and progress
Restate what they said	Notes
Letters	Positive affirmation
Hip, hip, hooray principle	Thumbs up/down
Write exact response – don't edit student unless meaning is wrong	

## Test taking strategies for Students:

Pre-read questions	Make study guides for tests
Use manipulatives	Interactive practice
Elimination	Practicing format
Study groups	Re-read
Reading strategies	Graphic organizers
Questioning	Open book
Projects	Students write test questions
Outline	Drawings – pictures
Classify	Drill in pairs
