What happens if I fail a class I need for graduation?

Did you know?

- 3,400 Granite School District students took a make-up class for graduation in 2004-2005 school year.
- Classes for credit make-up are available in most high schools.
- 27 credits are required for graduation from high school.
- Students can only take 9th grade geography in junior high or at the Granite Peaks Adult High School.

Granite Peaks Classes for Make-up:

If students fail a class they need for graduation, they will need to take a make-up class.

- Classes in all core subjects and a few electives needed for make-up are available at Granite Peaks.
- Students will need to bring a permission form from their school counselor that includes the specific class and credit needed in order to register for a make-up class.
- Classes are available year round.
- Students may be interested in the "A+" computer based make-up classes.
- Tuition is \$55 for .25 credit and \$78 for .5 credit.
- Books and supplies are not included in the tuition.
- Fee waivers apply.
