## How do I take Concurrent Enrollment classes?

### *Did you know?*

- All high schools have Concurrent Enrollment Classes.
- Check your registration cards for the code 'CC'.
- Check with your counselor to know which classes have Concurrent Enrollment attached to them

Concurrent Enrollment is one of the great opportunities for you while you are in high school. You can take certain classes and earn the regular high school credit for your graduation, and at the same time, you can earn college credit. The credit is transferable to any state college or state university. The concurrent enrollment classes allow you to enroll in college without the entrance requirements. There is a one-time fee for registration and some lab fees for certain classes. Concurrent Enrollment can help you earn credits toward an associate degree. With a good plan (SEOP), you can earn an associate degree at the same time as your high school diploma. Your senior year is a great time to get the Concurrent Enrollment classes in CTE or other advanced areas to prepare for work or college
