- Lee V. Stiff has taught mathematics in the middle grades, high school, and college since 1971. He is Professor of Mathematics Education, Associate Member of the Mathematics Department and Past President (2000-2002) of the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics. Dr. Stiff is a frequent speaker at local, state, regional, national, and international mathematics education conferences and meetings. He has conducted presentations and workshops with elementary, middle grades, high school, and college teachers of mathematics in American Samoa, Bermuda, Canada, China, Ghana, Japan, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and 41 of the states in these United States.
- Marcia Roberts is a full-time educational and corporate consultant, Marcia provides training workshops and consultation services both at the national and international level. She is known for her ability to connect with, and meet the needs of, diverse audiences. In addition to her own consulting, Marcia is an associate with Developing Minds, Inc. for which she presents "Worksheets Don't Grow Dendrites." Her favorite audiences are teachers.
