CERTIFICATE LEVEL	EDUCATION/JOB ENHANCEMENT Requirement: High School Graduate or Certificate of Equivalency	RECERTIFICATION  Requirement: Recertification to highest-level certificate or upgrade to a higher level every 5 years
Entry	Course documentation for 5 semesters university or college credit OR 100 hours of education in listed areas.	Course documentation for 60 hours of continuing education (any combination of courses, workshops, seminars)
Intermediate	Course documentation for 8 semesters university or college credit OR 175 hours of education in listed areas.	Course documentation for 60 hours of continuing education (any combination of courses, workshops, seminars)
Professional I	Course documentation for 11 semesters university or college credit OR 250 hours of education in listed areas	Course documentation for 60 hours of continuing education (any combination of courses, workshops, seminars)
Professional II	Course documentation for 14 semesters university or college credit OR 325 hours of education in listed areas	Course documentation for 60 hours of continuing education (any combination of courses, workshops, seminars)
Professional III/GCOP	Course documentation for 17 semesters university or college credit OR 400 hours of education in listed areas	Course documentation for 60 hours of continuing education (any combination of courses, workshops, seminars)

Recertification or Upgrading of Certificate Level	The current highest certificate level must be upgraded or recertified every five years to be considered current by Granite School District. <i>See the Granite School District Application for Recertification/Upgrade.</i>
Work Experience  3 Years	Three years experience is required for all Granite School District certificate levels. A fiscal or an academic year in an educational office is considered one year of experience. A year of teaching is considered one year experience. Each two years of work experience in office areas other than education is considered one year of experience. -1-
