Transition to Adult Life



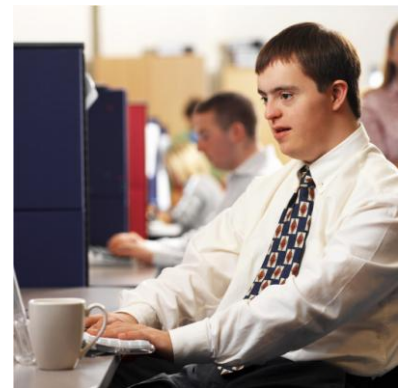
This is a **free** training offered by the Utah Parent Center. It will provide information on how to have a successful transition from school to post-secondary life for students with disabilities.
