



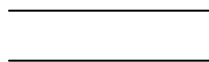
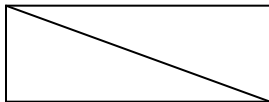
When the trail led us to the edge of a **quagmire**, we were in a **quagmire** about how to get around the large, muddy area.
