A **base word** can stand alone. A **prefix** and a **word root** are word parts. They cannot stand alone. A prefix is added to the beginning of a base word or a word root. It adds meaning to a word.

PREFIX + BASE WORD:	unable	disagree
PREFIX + WORD ROOT:	insist	report
