

Unit 5 – Spelling /ou/, /ô/, and /oi/

The /ou/, /ô/, /oi/ sounds are usually spelled with two letters. The patterns ou, au, and oi are usually followed by a consonant sound.

/ou/ **ounce, tower** /ô/ **claw, pause, bald** /oi/ **moist, loyal**
