

Community Council Minutes  
October 27, 2008

We took attendance and everyone signed the roll. Those in attendance were Teri Tillotson, Chris Inkley, Mayra Vazquez, Ramona Barela, Alma Hernandez, Marbella Orozco, Maria Hernandez, and Paul Gadilauskas, the Spanish translator.

We received the new digital recorder from Granite School District and used it for the first time during this meeting.

The minutes from last month were read, and we appreciate Teri Tillotson for notifying the mayor of our next meeting. Yvonne Pearson posted the minutes from last month on the school's website, and sent the Community Council membership to the school district.

A new QTSA proposal was discussed. This proposal was for teachers: Bigler, Chase and Veatch. The project was for math interventions before school for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. They requested 137 hours to serve an estimated 20-45 students. The project will be evaluated through student assessments, attendance and teacher survey. The cost of the project is \$4000. The proposal was approved by the council.

We are excited about the new school addition. Because the school needed to transfer 17 classrooms, the school needed to have several early release days. A letter stating these changes was sent out to all parents.

We also mentioned the school's Parent Compact letter. The Compacts are signed by parents during the upcoming SEP conferences. Mrs. Pearson went over the teacher responsibilities and the parent responsibilities with the council.
