Curriculum

The curriculum taught in the classroom addresses the objectives outlined in the Utah State Core. This will be accomplished through a variety of teaching methods. For reading your child has been placed in a group that best meets their needs and will have the opportunity to work with one of the teachers on the fifth grade team.

Classroom Expectations

The expectations (rules) are based off those implemented by Hillsdale Elementary.

- Respect
- Follow Directions the First Time
- KYHFOOTY- Keep your hands feet and other objects to yourself.

Each student keeps a log book to record their behavior that violates the classroom/school rules. This log book is also used as a classroom check book. Each student has an opportunity to earn classroom money according to behavior, responsibility, and work completion. This money is used for a variety of activities.

If a student's behavior violates a classroom/school rule they will be asked to acknowledge the wrong behavior and what behavior should replace it. If the problem continues through the day we will call home to make you aware of it.

For more serious violations (i.e. safe school) or repeat of same wrong behavior this system of warnings is not follow. The student may be asked to report to the school administrator. Here the student will work through the problem and return to class when appropriate.

Grades/Homework

Grades are based on rubrics, tests, assignments, discussions, and class participation. To keep you informed of your student's progress a folder will be sent home every Monday. This folder will inform you if your student has any missing work along with corrected assignments and notes. Every third week expect an up-to-date progress note. This folder should be signed and return to school the following day.

Your student will have the opportunity to finish all work in class. Work that is not finished in class is to be completed as homework. If your student is absent it is expected that they complete missed work within one week.

To earn full credit on an assignment it must be turn in within the week it was due. After that date a percentage of the assignment may be dropped. To give the appropriate amount of practice all work must be turned in.
