

Test Taking Vocabulary Word of the Week

The vocabulary word and definition can be found on the back of this handout. You may want to post it in your room to refer to and to review with.

CORRECTLY (correct)-pick the right answer, no mistakes

Examples to Share with Your Class:

1. If all of your spelling words are *correct* you will get 100% on the test.
2. Mom told me to measure all of the ingredients *correctly* when I made cookies so they would turn out just right.
3. Tom can pass off all of his “5” times tables *correctly* in one minute.
4. The teacher asked the students to put the crayons away in the *correct* containers.
5. My family visited France and had trouble speaking the French language *correctly*.
6. The expanded form of the number 3,579 is *correctly* written as: 3,000 + 500 + 70 + 9.
7. The band students played the *correct* notes of the music when they practiced their songs.
8. Paleontologists *correctly* identify dinosaur bones as part of their research.

Teaching Ideas:

1. Math Story Problems: Give students several equation choices. Have students find the *correct* equation that would solve story problems appropriate for your grade level. CRT questions will often ask for just the correct equation rather than the answer to the problem.
2. Spelling: Have students find the *correct* spelling of an underlined word in a sentence or passage. Offer students several spelling choices with only one correct answer. This is also a common format for CRTs.

Synonyms- right, accurate, exact, truthful, properly,
fittingly, suitably

Antonyms- wrong, incorrect
