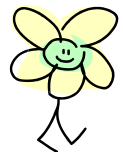

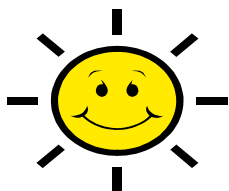

No one guessed that Mrs. Freestone went to Sturgis Motorcycle rally in South Dakota.

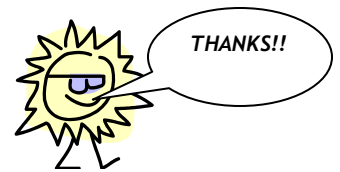
## TEACHER APPRECIATION WEEK "My Favorite Things"
