i) Agenda Items

- (1) Progress on reading programs for next year
  - (a) Incoming sophomores will be placed in a reading class by recommendation. Junior and Senior enrollment will be determined by testing scores. The funding will come from FTE resources and the on-line test will be funded by Trustland funds. This class will use an elective. A mandatory double-blocked course is being considered: one English class and one reading class.
- (2) Changes in QTSA funding
  - (a) All QTSA funding has been cut. In addition to other programs, these funds usually pay for teacher's salaries for the 5 days before school starts.
  - (b) The SSAP will also be affected. We will need to evaluate how the school will fund programs such as Adopt-a-Sophomore, after-school tutoring, the parent call program, and the Cornell notes program.
- (3) Dress standard for dances
  - (a) There has been inappropriate attire at the dances this year.
  - (b) Mr. Perschon will check with Paul Hansen, Granite District Director of Senior Schools, to determine how we can establish a dress code.
  - (c) Kim Bryan will check with Bountiful, Woods Cross, and other schools in the area about their dress code and subsequent challenges.
  - (d) The PTA will check with parents to get an opinion on the value of a dress code for school functions, including dances.
  - (e) Once established, the dress code will be published in the Pirate Scope and in the registration packet.
- (4) District Community Council Elections
  - (a) A council is being formed at a district level for the Cyprus network. It will consist of 16 members. Members must have a child currently in the network. The nomination deadline is April 1, 2009. This first year, offices will be staggered between one and two years.
- (5) Results of local Community Council Elections
  - (a) Two new parents were voted in:
    - (i) Lu Penfold and Tracy Atkinson.
    - (ii) Trish Hull will invite them to the next meeting.
