

# Olympus High Clash of the Titans 10 Team Tournament

Welcome to the Clash of the Titans Wrestling Tournament. One of the most unique wrestling tournaments in Utah. This tournament combines the organization of a dual match tournament and the excitement of a traditional format, wrestling a true finals round.

Standard 14 weight classes with a 1lb weight allowance Friday, 2lb weight allowance on Saturday.

Medals awarded to the top four wrestlers in each weight class.

Two Outstanding Wrestler awards:

Lightweights (103-140)

Heavyweights (145-275)

Each team is in a 5 team pool (Pool A, Pool B) and will have 4 matches and 1 bye.

The top two wrestlers at each weight class in their bracket will advance to the medal round.

In order to qualify for the medal round the wrestler must wrestle all four matches in the same weight class.

Medal Round Criteria:

- 1 Most Wins in Weight Class
- 2 Head to Head
- 3 Total Team Points Scored - in four matches
- 4 Most 6 Point Wins, 5 Point Wins, 4 Point Wins
- 5 Most Takedowns

During the medal rounds, wrestlers will be wrestling for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place medals and scoring points towards the team trophies. The number one ranked wrestler from pool A will wrestle the number two ranked wrestler from pool B. The number one wrestler from pool B will wrestle number two from pool A. Winners will wrestle winners for first and second place, and losers will wrestle losers for third and fourth.

The team points will be scored in the Semi-Finals and Finals as follows:

| 14 points for 1 <sup>st</sup> Place | 2 bonus points for each Win by Fall (Pin)               |
| 10 points for 2 <sup>nd</sup> Place | 1.5 bonus points for each Tech Fall (win by >14 pts)    |
| 7 points for 3 <sup>rd</sup> Place  | 1 bonus point for a Major Decision (win by 8 to 14 pts) |
| 4 points for 4 <sup>th</sup> Place  | No points for Advancement                               |

Teams will be separated into pools by seeding the top four teams and drawing in the others. Teams in the same region will be separated. Seeding will be done by ranking points taken from returning region top four wrestlers and state placers.
