The student, parent, and administration agree to the following conditions affecting the student's academic performance, citizenship performance, and behavior while at Granite Park Middle School.

Academic

1. The student will do his/her best to pass all classes at Granite Park Middle School.
2. The student will maintain a minimum of a 2.0 G.P.A.
3. The student will go to class prepared. This includes bringing all materials and assignments.
4. The student will use his/her time in class effectively. This includes participation and the completion of class work.
5. The student will attend after school and Saturday school tutoring if she/he is academically behind in school.

Citizenship

6. The student will go to class on time. The student will have no unexcused tardies.
7. The student will go to every class. All absences must be excused within two days. Sluffing will not be tolerated.
8. The student will have no zeros (0) in citizenship.

Behavior

9. The student will show respect in class. This means all classroom rules must be followed. The teacher will be treated as the authority figure in the classroom. If there are concerns, the student or parent will contact the administration.
10. The student will show respect in the school. This includes no disrespectful language or insults towards students or staff, no horseplay in the halls, spreading rumors, or other actions which show disrespect to any person or property.
11. Fighting, threat of fighting, and sexual harassment will not be tolerated.
12. The use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol will not be tolerated.
13. Safe school violations will not be tolerated.
14. The school dress code will be followed (see reverse side).

Failure to follow these conditions may result in the student's referral to an alternative program, an altered schedule, or disciplinary action, including Saturday detention, after school detention, lunch detention, in school suspension, out of school suspension, or school service. In all cases we will attempt to notify parents. We offer an after school bus and may detain students after school when parents are unable to be reached.

All students are required to turn in this contract as part of the registration process. Parents who have concerns with any of this entire contract may schedule an appointment to discuss the contract with Mr. Anderson Ms. Stirling or Mr. Scott.

DRESS CODE

THE DRESS CODE IS VERY SPECIFIC. PLEASE BUY APPROPRIATE CLOTHES!

Granite Park expects students to dress for success. This includes, but is not limited to:

Tops: All tops must cover the shoulder completely. They may not be sheer, see-through, mesh, or netted. Tops exposing the mid-drift and/or distracting clothing may not be worn. All tops must be worn on the right side (no inside out). Numbers, any depiction of weapons, pictures, and Old English will be restricted according to current recommendation by the Metro Gang Task Force.

Bottoms: Bottoms are to be worn at the natural waist. Sagging, baggy, tight fitting, spandex, lycra, and torn or frayed bottoms are not allowed. Skirts, dresses jumpers, and shorts must approach the knee in length and cover at least three fourths of the thigh. Cutoffs, jersey/sport and pajama bottoms are not allowed. No undergarments may be exposed. Numbers, any depiction of weapons, pictures, and Old English will be restricted according to current recommendation by the Metro Gang Task Force.

Accessories: Accessories, such as chains on wallets and spikes are not permitted at school. No hats, scarves, bandanas, gloves, sunglasses, or coats may be worn in the building. These items should be kept in the locker.

Shoes: Students must wear proper shoes at all times: no slippers, no colored shoe laces, only black or white shoelaces will be permitted.

Hair: Students must maintain natural hair colors. Hair should not be spiked, colored, or otherwise distracting to learning.

Backpacks: Backpacks, bags, and purses are to be kept in the lockers. Students only need to carry notebooks, books, planners and pencils to class.

Colors: Students must wear multiple colors (example: white shirt and blue pants). No blue on blue, red on red, black on black, etc. This along with any other dress code issue as determined to be a concern by the Metro Gang Task Force are all part of the school's dress code.

Students who choose not to follow the dress code will have parents notified and may be sent home until proper attire is obtained. When parents cannot be reached, students will be referred to detention.

Gym Dress Code

Granite Park expects all students to dress for success in gym. This includes:

Appropriate shoes. Shoes must have non-marking soles (no black). No sandals, heels, slippers, etc. In other words, athletic shoes only.

Shirts must be a solid color. No numbers, pictures, or multicolored shirts allowed.

Pants must be either an appropriate gym short or sweat pant. They must be a solid color. No numbers, pictures, or multicolored shorts or sweat pants allowed.

Must wear multiple colors (example white shirt and blue pants). No blue on blue, red on red, black on black, etc.

KEEP IT AT HOME!

Items not required for specific classroom instruction and participation should be left at home. This includes, but is not limited to, music, roller blades, skateboards, CD players, MP3 players Gameboys, toys, pagers, cellular phones, and cameras. These items will be held until parents pick

them up. All unclaimed items will be donated to charity on July 1, 2009.

There have been many problems in the past two years involving skateboards and scooters. All students live within walking distance or are bussed. These items may not be brought to school and stored in lockers. **The school will**

not investigate stolen items that are not to be at the school. Bikes may be brought and chained at the bike rack. Those who bring bikes do so at their own risk.
