

## Dress Code

Dress and grooming should be neat, modest, and not disruptive to the learning environment.

**Students may not rely on a jacket or backpack as a means of complying with the dress code.**

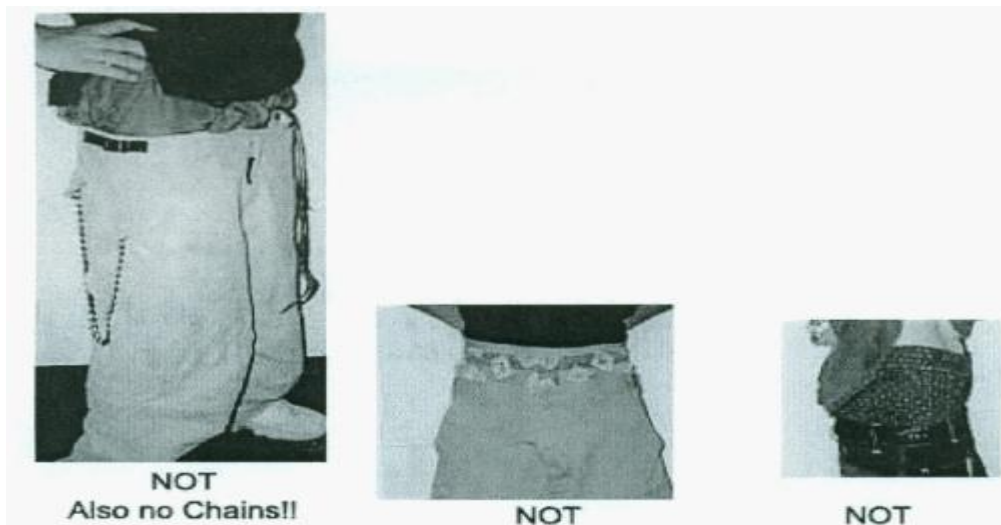
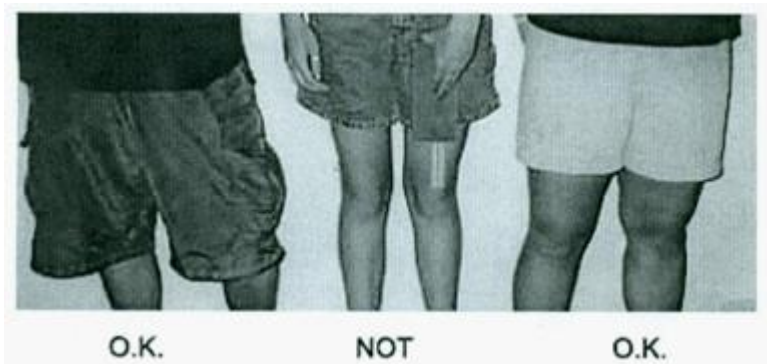
### Bottoms

1) Shorts and skirts must cover at least three fourths of the distance between the natural waist and the top of the knee.



- Pants must ride at the natural waist.

2) All shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be no more than 4 inches above the top of the knee.

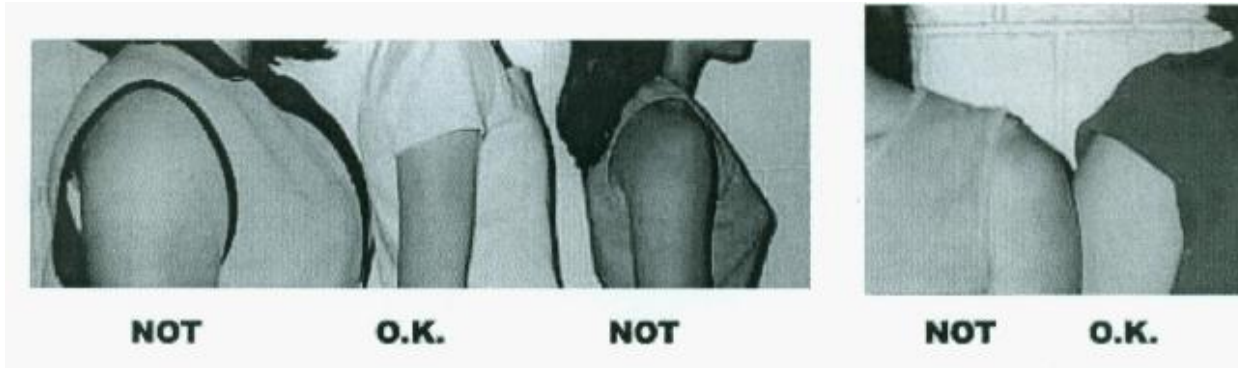


## Shirts/Tops must have sleeves (boys or girls).

- The belt buckle cannot have gang symbols or anything illegal.

### Tops

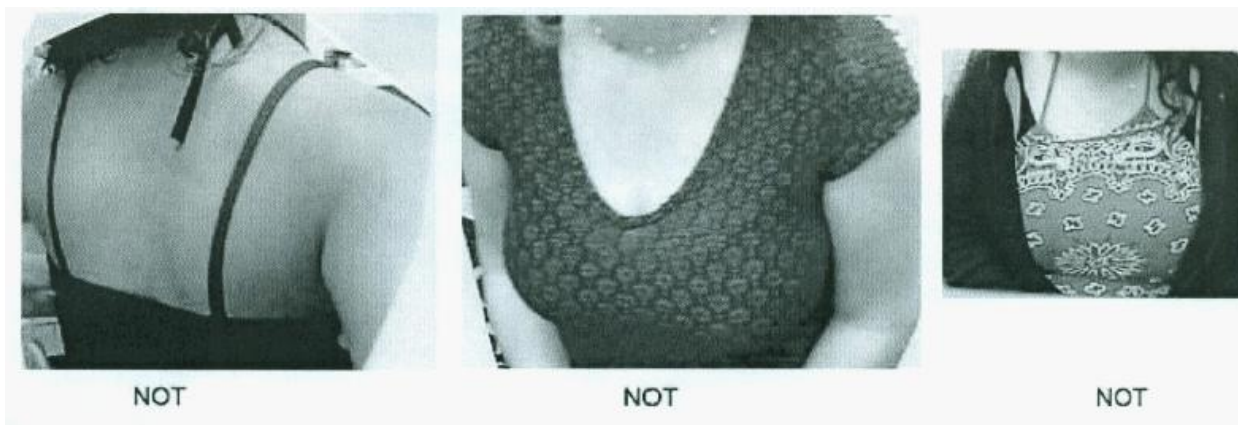
#### 1) Shirts/Tops must have sleeves (boys or girls).



Blouses and shirts, for male and female students, are not to be revealing, i.e. Tank tops, French cuts, midriff baring tops, and tops with spaghetti straps are not permissible. No clothing which reveals underwear is permissible. As a bench mark: Shirts must be buttoned to within 1½ inches below collar bone or have a neck line no lower than 1½ inch below collar bone.

### Cleavage must be covered.

**Students may not rely on a jacket or backpack as a means of complying with the dress code.**

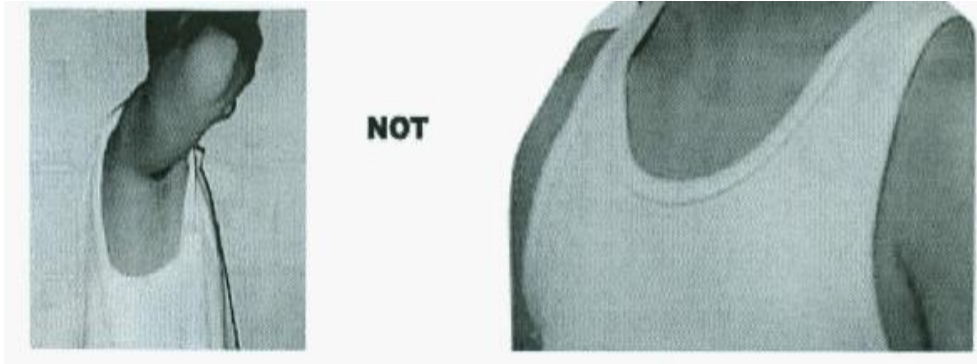


- Shirts: No midriffs, no see-through material, no strapless, no tank tops, no spaghetti straps, no low cut necklines.



- Sleeveless shirts must cover the shoulder extending to the edge of the shoulder and be at least 3 inches wide.
  - They must also come up to the arm pit.

**3) Shirts/Tops must come up to the arm pit on the sides.**



- No skin showing between shirt and bottoms at any time.

**4) Shirts/Tops must be long enough for the midriff to remain covered during regular movement.**

### **Headwear**

- Hats, bandannas, **hoods**, or other types of head coverings are not permitted.

Gang Apparel:



1. Excessively baggy clothing
2. Belts worn excessively long in the front and hanging on either side.
3. Boy Scout style buckle with the initials of the person or gang etched on it.
4. Baseball hat or other cap with gang symbols, monikers, or insignia on it, particular on inside of brim.
5. Bandannas or rags worn on a person or displayed.

### **Shoes**

- **Shoes must be worn at all times**, bedroom or house slippers are not acceptable foot wear.

### **Accessories**

- Attachments such as: chains, chokers, spikes or any excessive amounts of accessories are considered a risk to the health and safety of students or cause a distraction from the education of students. **These items are not allowed.**

## **General Guidelines**

- Clothing or accessories that express affiliation or sympathy with gang activities as defined by the Salt Lake Metro Gang Task Force are prohibited.
  - Parents are encouraged to examine the Metro Gang “Dress Down” clothing flyer.
- Clothing that is vulgar, has sexual connotations, or is degrading to or discriminates against either a group or individual is prohibited.
  - Clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol or tobacco are prohibited.
    - Underclothes must not be visible.
