Discussion of Land Trust Program application.

*One aide used exclusively to do testing for reading classes, another also helps with reading classes, and the third does tracking. Land Trust funds are also paying for one hour per day for one aide to do lunch supervision.

*Overview of the current Land Trust application entries.

*Comparisons of test scores for students receiving services under Land Trust program will not align exactly because the 40 students change on a consistent basis.

***Academic Goals #3 should be changed to: “Kennedy Jr. High has the goal of raising CRT scores of student being served by the academic assistants in math and reading by 5% and that minority subgroups will achieve minimum requirements.**

***Planned expenditures under #3** should be changed to: “Should we receive an increase in funding, we will increase the number of students served, proportionate to the allocation of funds.”

*Should minority groups be targeted for special funding to help them pass AYP?
