



NEW AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

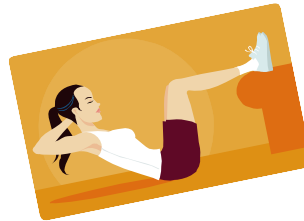
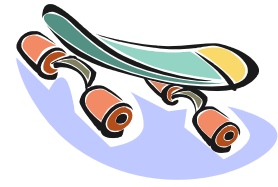
At Valley Junior High School
