

Article VI.E.1            School Food Services General Responsibilities

- A. All school food services provided by the District shall be in full accordance with federal and state laws, regulations, and guidelines; agreements with the District; and rules and regulations established by the Utah State Board of Education. (See Administrative Memorandum No. 64.)
- B. School food services shall provide nutritional lunches and breakfasts at minimal cost. The District shall support the state policy of providing free meals or reduced-priced meals for students unable to pay the full price.
- C. Reimbursable school lunches that meet the specified USDA minimum requirements shall be served. Breakfast program meals shall also meet all USDA minimum requirements. À la carte items may be sold in locations where it is deemed to be in the best economic interest of the school foods program.
- D. The meal charge to students in the elementary, junior high, and senior high schools and to adults shall be established by the Board.
- E. Food shall not be served for consumption outside of schools or approved school service sites with two exceptions: (1) food provided for special functions or events sponsored by the District or school and approved by administration, and (2) food and catering provided by the GEC Café.
