

Article X.B.1. Career & Technical Education General Responsibilities

A. Statement of Purpose

Career & Technical Education is an integral part of our education system. It is the policy of the District to provide training for students in various trades and occupations to prepare them with skills needed in the work force. The District is also responsive to the needs of the community and in assessing employment trends.

Career Education is introduced into courses whenever it is appropriate. It extends from elementary through twelfth grade and is for all students. At the elementary level the focus is on awareness, at the junior high on orientation, and at senior high on career exploration.

Work and service experiences are a cooperative effort between school and community and relate specifically to graduation requirements.
