

Article III.B. Appointment of Superintendent

The superintendent of schools is appointed by the Board of Education and serves as the Board's chief executive officer. The appointment shall occur at the Board's first meeting in June. The superintendent's term of office begins July 1 and is for two years or until a successor is appointed and qualified. The superintendent shall hold an administrative/supervisory certificate issued by the State Board of Education. The board shall set the superintendent's compensation for services. The superintendent qualifies for office by taking the constitutional oath of office. (Utah Code 53G-4-301).
