A SAFE ENVIRONMENT AT SCHOOL



In-person instruction will follow a traditional Monday-Friday schedule, with modifications for safety and social distancing.



Teachers and staff will wear face coverings at school, and school plans will allow for appropriate social distancing.




Per state mandate, face coverings are required for students and anyone visiting the school, and on buses. Face coverings will be provided for students.



Building cleaning/disinfecting schedules will be enhanced, and each school will have an isolated health room.








Accommodations will be made for students with an IEP/504, or other needs.

Students will be sent home if they come to school while sick. Parents must ensure their contact information is up to date with the school in the event their student needs to be picked up for any reason.

PLANNING AHEAD



We are prepared to shift to a modified daily/weekly schedule or a full dismissal if recommended by the health department.



In the event of a local outbreak, classrooms or entire schools may be dismissed for a period of time.
